### YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE – PAYMENT CARD FEE SETTLEMENT

Businesses that accepted Visa and/or Mastercard between 2004 and 2019 are eligible to claim a share of a \$5.5 billion settlement from an anti-trust lawsuit claiming that the companies overcharged their customers. Initial estimates are that those who file claims may be eligible for between \$3,000 and \$5,000 for every million charged. The deadline to file a claim is Feburary 4, 2025, though, so you need to act quickly. You can find more information about the process here: https://www.paymentcardsettlement.com/en

### NEW YEAR GOAL: ENHANCING OUR EMAIL PRACTICES

As we welcome the new year, Wade Hampton, CEO of the Indiana Alliance, sent this suggestion for improving our email communication to boost efficiency and respect everyone's time.

A key aspect of this is using the **Blind Carbon Copy (BCC)** feature when sending group emails. This practice offers several benefits:

- Reduces Email Overload: The average employee spends about 28% of their workweek managing emails, equating to 13 hours per week. By using BCC, we can minimize unnecessary "Reply All" responses, helping to decrease this workload.
- Protects Privacy: BCC keeps recipients' email addresses confidential, preventing unintended sharing of personal information.
- Prevents Email Storms: Misuse of "Reply All" can lead to email storms, overwhelming inboxes and disrupting productivity.

By adopting the BCC feature for group emails, we can make our communication more efficient and considerate.


